1. Look Up—**REDIRECT YOUR WORSHIP**. Titus 2:11-12

Titus 2:11-14 — 11 For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people,

12 training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age,

2. Look Ahead—**RAISE YOUR EXPECTATIONS**. Titus 2:13

13 waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,

3. Look Back—**RESTORE YOUR GRATITUDE**. Titus 2:14

What was God's purpose in sending His Son into this world to be our Savior?

14 who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works.

7. What did Jesus redeem us for (v.14)?
8. What would it look like for you to be zealous for good works (v.14)?
9. What emotions do you feel when you think about Jesus coming into this world the first time?
10. What emotions do you feel when you think about Jesus coming back into this world the second time?
