Agriculture & Livestock

You may enjoy growing your own fresh tomatoes or collecting fresh eggs from your own backyard chickens, but for many of the world's hungry, like farmer Piolo, gardens and livestock are the primary source of food and income.

Piolo sold food to people in the city but still didn't have enough money for his family. In between planting and harvesting, Piolo would walk to town with two buckets on his shoulders—the badge worn by a vendor of *taho*, a popular sweet treat.

Two out of every five people in the world live in extreme poverty, and many of those live in rural communities that are the most vulnerable to climate and economic events. BGR projects have proven to be sustainable, economic, and effective in making agriculture benefit farmers, too—but farmers must first learn about them. *Your financial gift helps BGR equip Piolo and his fellow rural farmers with training, starter seeds, and livestock so they can make their families self-sufficient.*

Donors like you helped Piolo learn how to raise and sell hogs. Now he makes enough to provide for his wife and eight children and to invest in his *taho* business. The purchase of a motorbike means he can make the trip to town more easily. Even better, he says, it means he can get home earlier to be with his family!

Such small gifts—a cow, a chicken, some seeds—yet with them you can put a family on the path to **achieving the dignity of providing for themselves**. Give today to plant the seeds of tomorrow for a family like Piolo's.

PAIR OF PIGS

\$50

Pigs can produce at least 10 piglets from each pregnancy and may have two litters each year. Farmers receive better varieties that grow quickly, so they can sell them within a few months and feed their families. Farmers are also trained on how to raise them properly and improve their pig raising.

You shall give to him freely, and your heart shall not be grudging when you give to him, because for this the LORD your God will bless you in all your work and in all that you undertake. (Deuteronomy 15:10)

SEEDS

\$10

By providing starter seeds and training in gardening, you can transform families like Azra's. Her husband is a fisherman and barely makes enough to feed their three children. Since receiving a kit of starter seeds, Azra has grown local and better varieties of vegetables to provide vital nutrition for her family and additional income by selling some of her produce.

You cause the grass to grow for the livestock and plants for man to cultivate, that he may bring forth food from the earth. (Psalm 104:14)





10 CHICKENS

\$25

Giving a family chickens is an excellent way to combat hunger. Chickens are easy and inexpensive to care for, and they can be raised and bred in small areas. Their eggs provide a nutritious source of food for a family and can be sold for extra income.

And God blessed them saying, “Be fruitful and multiply and fill the waters in the seas, and let birds multiply on the earth.” (Genesis 1:22)



GOAT

\$75

When you give someone a goat, you provide them with a good source of nutritious milk, and they can earn a sustainable income by selling excess milk and breeding the goat. A goat gave Zaid, who hadn't worked since he was crippled in an accident, a way to earn a living. Now he's saving the money he earns from selling the newborn goats to open a small grocery store.

And God said, “Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind.” And it was so. (Genesis 1:24)



PAIR OF RABBITS

\$25

Rabbits reproduce rapidly and are a low-cost source of food and income for a family. Nanda is a widow raising her young grandson alone. She received a pair of rabbits from friends like you. Since then, she has already raised more than 30 rabbits to sell!

Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have, for such sacrifices are pleasing to God. (Hebrews 13:16)

COW

\$300

Share the cost:

Cows are especially useful for people with access to large grazing areas. They generate nutritious milk and provide owners with sustainable income through the sale of excess milk and calves. When you give a family a cow, you give them years of financial security.

Where there are no oxen, the manger is clean, but abundant crops come by the strength of the ox. (Proverbs 14:4)





10 FISH

\$3

You can help a family grow fish in a small pond or tank—just like Bakti does. He received fish hatchlings that now supplement his family's diet. Ten fish grow and reproduce rapidly, and they're inexpensive to keep.

For he satisfies the longing soul, and the hungry soul he fills with good things. (Psalm 107:9)



SHEEP

\$100

A family might spend years trying to make enough income from their farm to sustain themselves. But they can still be hungry. When friends like you give them a sheep, their financial situation improves. The family uses the sheep's wool, milk, and meat to earn an income.

He will tend his flock like a shepherd; he will gather the lambs in his arms... (Isaiah 40:11)



Human Trafficking

Nita's story shows how human trafficking is not just about being rescued; **there's also a long process of recovery.**

Nita came to a rescue home a severely damaged young woman. She had witnessed the deaths of her father and other members of her family, and she had been abused and exploited by several people, including a person of power.

The staff worried about Nita because she rarely spoke and would often fall ill, even though she had no medical problems. But they knew that Nita faced a situation too horrifying for any person. Everywhere she turned she was reminded of her past.

Traffickers take advantage of society's forgotten—what Jesus called “the least of these.” In Matthew 25:40, he says, “whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.” You allow BGR to receive and heal those damaged by trafficking and exploitation in the name of Jesus.

Give now to provide a safe place for abused girls. Your gift helps trafficked girls begin the long road to recovery and a new life in the loving care of the people of God.

But let justice roll down like waters, and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream. (Amos 5:24)

MEDICAL CARE FOR A MONTH



Formerly trafficked children like Minoti often have serious medical and health care needs. She was forced to work 20 hours a day and was frequently mistreated and abused. After escaping to a BGR shelter, Minoti is slowly healing physically and emotionally—and she needs specialized care.

Clean Water

Clean water issues in your local community can cause concern for your children's health, but what if you were told your child had a **60% chance of dying from a water-borne illness?** That was the case for Shoaib's small village. Most of the men are poor laborers working for wealthy landowners. Everyone drank from a dirty canal nearby and was often in danger of water-borne sickness or death—especially kids.

BGR donors provided two wells—which Shoaib and his large extended family helped to dig and install. The community now knows the basic security of having clean drinking water, and they have become a hub for nearby villages who also need clean water.

Your gift of a well or filter sends **the simple message that God wants everyone—rich or poor—to have access to such a basic thing as clean water.** Your gift tells families like Shoaib's that their children matter to you and to God.

Your gift also shows the love of Christ as our teams work beside and educate local villagers in community health education.

WATER WELL

\$1,000

Everybody needs access to clean water. But many villages around the world are still without a well. Jacob's school now has one, and he has plenty of safe water to drink. He can even bathe regularly and play in clean clothing! By installing community water systems, entire villages can have clean water for years to come.

...but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him will never be thirsty again. (John 4:14)

WATER FILTER

\$25

In some places, people drink contaminated water that makes them sick. Water filters and basic education about how to sterilize pots and cook off the ground can save many lives. With one water filter, you can supply clean water for a family of five to six people for a year.

For truly, I say to you, whoever gives you a cup of water to drink because you bear the name of Christ will by no means lose the reward. (Mark 9:41)





Health Care



For I will restore health to you, and your wounds I will heal, declares the Lord, because they have called you an outcast. (Jeremiah 30:17)

The baby was coming, but Jehan and her midwife knew something was wrong. Jehan lives in a poor, mountainous region of her Asian country. The only way to get her to the hospital was for her family to carry her on a woven mat. She arrived at 1 a.m. in critical condition, and staff immediately and prayerfully began to assist her.

Two hours later Jehan delivered a healthy baby girl. Her husband credits the BGR-supported clinic workers with saving the baby, and Jehan believes they saved her life.

While we in developed countries have ready access to advanced medical treatment, the world's

poorest communities often lack even basic resources. Nine out of ten of Jehan's neighbors live in poverty, and many villages in the area lack roads that could take them to care centers.

Your gift of medical supplies helps BGR and its partners provide for impoverished communities and in cases of disaster. You can equip doctors and nurses to be the hands and feet of the God who heals, and you can help alleviate the dangers to mothers and children in poor, remote areas.

Thousands of people depend on mobile clinics and rural hospitals for lifesaving medical care. Khaltouma got treatment and antibiotics for an abscess that was preventing her from eating. But many others are turned away when clinics aren't fully stocked. You can ensure more people get the medical care they desperately need.

5 Ways to Use the BGR Gift Catalog with Kids

One of the greatest gifts a parent can give a child is an understanding of compassion and a sense of self-efficacy. As children learn about the needs of others, they can also be taught that they can do something to help and be guided in the process of responding to a need. The BGR catalog is a wonderful tool to begin integrating these concepts into your child's world.

Here are just a few ways you can use the BGR catalog with the children in your life.

1. Select an item from the catalog together and find ways to creatively fundraise for it. Here are a few ideas to get you started:

- **Hold a bake sale or lemonade stand.** Let your kids shop for the ingredients, prepare the items, and set up a stand at the end of your driveway, in a nearby park, at your church, or other location. (Call ahead to make sure you are allowed to sell items at your locale of choice!)
- **Have an art show.** Let your child's inner Picasso come out by creating paintings or crafts to sell in your neighborhood or other approved, safe location.
- **Yard sales are always a great fundraiser.** For this yard sale, help your children sort through their clothes, toys, games, and other items. Help them price the items, talk to customers at the sale, and handle the money exchange.

- **Don't forget to advertise!** Whatever sale you decide to have, let your kids make flyers to pass around town, in your church, or at their school. You could also consider contacting community calendars, informing your child's teacher of the event, or even posting an announcement online.

2. Give an animal, get an animal! Let your child pick out an animal in the catalog to donate and get them a stuffed replica! Encourage them to keep that stuffed animal in a place they will see it every day as a reminder to pray for the family who will receive the animal you donated.

3. It's better to give than to get! Let your kids experience the truth of this sentiment by "giving their birthday" to BGR. Instead of asking for presents, they can ask friends and family for ten fish, chickens, or water filters!

4. Make prayer a habit! Pick an item with your child to donate. Then, pray for the recipient of that gift every night or every morning.

5. Keep the change! Every time you break a dollar, let your child keep the change in a piggy bank or jar. At the end of the month, count out the money to see how much they can donate to BGR! If they want to donate a more expensive item, teach them the value of saving month to month until they reach their goal.

Disaster Response

Hurricane Irma, the Guatemalan volcano eruption, the Rohingya crisis. When natural or man-made disaster strikes, the magnitude of the damage and casualties overwhelms us and grieves our hearts. We want to know what we can do.

Your gift of a home, cookware, or even a tarp may feel small, **but small gifts make a huge impact** on a single person or on a family. And that's how we begin to rebuild communities.

Christine is a 75-year-old widow in the Caribbean. She is the sole caregiver for her wheelchair-bound adult daughter, Violetta. When Hurricane Irma swept through the islands, it hit their home hard. Fortunately, the structure survived, but they needed clean water and a new wheelchair ramp among other essentials. Another daughter's home, next door, was completely gone, and she and her three children had to move in with Christine.

Because of support from people like you, BGR was there to help. You helped to replace the water pipes and ramp as well as windows, doors, and paint so the house was livable again. The local team leader continues to offer what support he can, but they still need new furniture and the financial means to survive as a household of six.

Refugee Relief

I imagine being told you had to leave your home suddenly, in the night. What would you take with you? How would it feel to look back on your home as you hike into the hills, not knowing if you will ever see it again?

How bad would things have to get before you took such a step?

Maybe it starts with unjust laws by harsh authorities. There's a curfew, now, and people are killed on any suspicion of disobeying. Food and water become scarce. You look at your family each night not knowing what you will feed them the next day.

Then a soldier knocks on your door and says your son must join them, and become one of their fighters. What would you do?

Mahmoud and his family faced just this situation. They were content farming wheat, barley, and vegetables in their small mountain village. Then an extremist group moved in with their violent rule. They began killing people, including some

of Mahmoud's family and neighbors. **They told the village they would take their children for soldiers.**

What could he do? Mahmoud pulled his son out of school, packed up a few belongings, and moved his family to a refugee camp in the provincial capital.

Now they are safe, but they face new challenges. Mahmoud is grateful for the help he has already received from people like you. But families in the camps struggle day to day to get adequate food and water. The children lack schooling, and the cold winters mean they need to stockpile plenty of fuel. All this while they look for work in the city.

Your gifts of blankets, food, etc., will help us distribute relief kits to families like Mahmoud's. Your support helps show Mahmoud and his new community that Christ is the God of the stranger—that **for Christ there are no strangers**. Give today to give Mahmoud a tomorrow.

Many refugees battle to survive cold winters, with children and the elderly most at risk. Warm blankets are critical for keeping people alive in subzero temperatures when they have no access to heating.

FOOD BOX

Most refugee families have endured disasters or fled armed conflicts. Masoud's family fled Syria and settled in a neighboring country—but it's hard to find work. By providing a food packet, you can feed a family of six for one month. It contains staple items like rice, flour, salt, oil, sugar, and tea.

Is it not to share your bread with the hungry and bring the homeless poor into your house... (Isaiah 58:7)



Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men. (Colossians 3:23)

Microenterprise & Job Skills

With a little training and a little money, people can do amazing things to make lives for themselves and their families. While our relief programs help people find stability in their lives, our **microenterprise and job skills programs help people build brighter futures for themselves.**

A simple course at a sewing training center in South Asia empowers women to earn incomes as secondary and even primary breadwinners. Sometimes, as in the case of Kishwar, they can use their income to fund further education.

Kishwar lives with her mother and younger brother; her father abandoned them years ago. Because of your donations, she took a class and learned sewing and henna art and then went into business for herself. **With the money she**

earns, she can help her family as well as take computer classes at the local college. One day, she will be able to do even more for her family with a job in computers.
